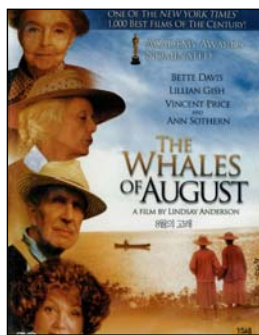

***Mr. Hobbs Takes a Vacation***

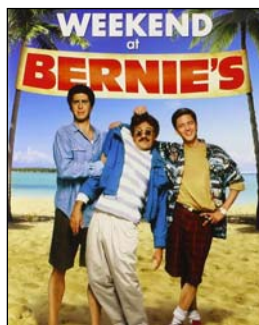
