- For reservations, call **one business day in advance**.

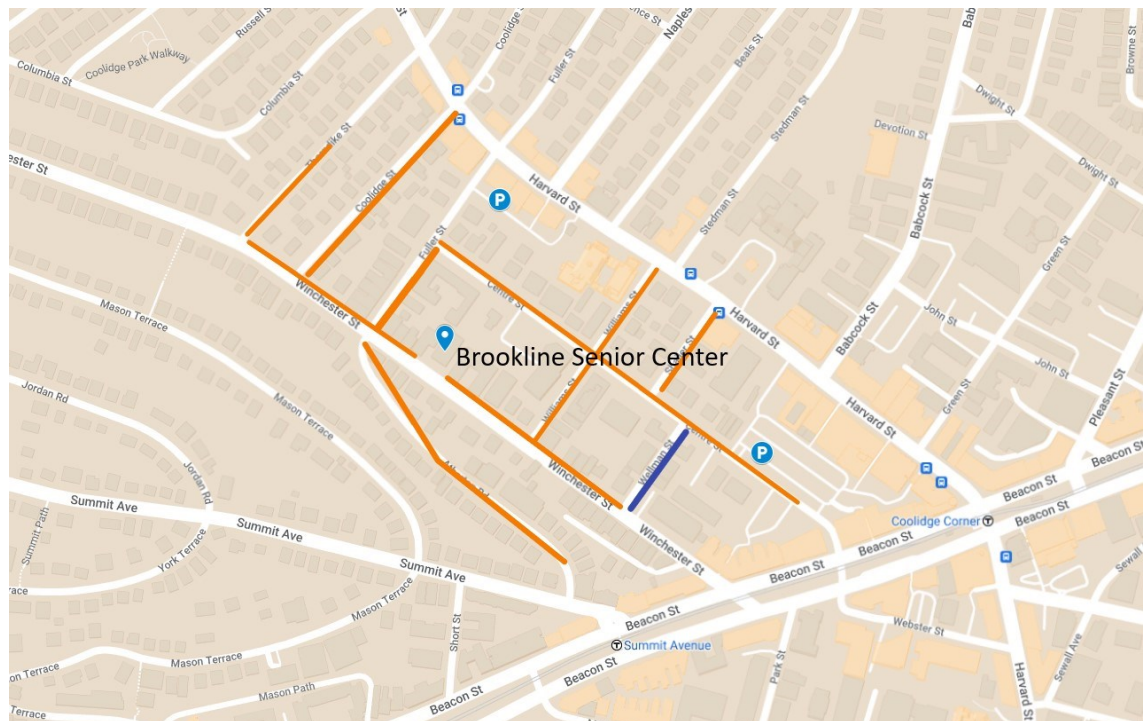
### Parking Options

#### LOTS

- Fuller Street Lot -  
First 4 Spaces
- Centre Street Parking Lot  
(4-hour parking @ \$2.00  
per hour)



**\*\*Helpful Hint:** Atherton is one-way and accessed via Summit Avenue off Beacon Street (westbound).  
Atherton parking is available after 10AM and there are often spaces available.

# Other Transportation Options

## Subsidized Lyft or GoGo Rides

- C Line (Summit Avenue T-stop (big step off train) or Coolidge Corner T-Stop (accessible).
- 66 Bus T-Stops (Harvard and Shailer or Harvard and Stedman).

## MBTA “The Ride”

Call: (617) 337-2727

- Paratransit service provides door-to-door, shared ride transportation to eligible people who are unable to use the MBTA’s fixed route transit (bus, subway, trolley) some or all of the time due to physical, cognitive or mental disability.
- Eligibility interview required.
