some suggestions.

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- If you are able, make a monetary donation to the Brookline Food Pantry ([brooklinefoodpantry.org](http://brooklinefoodpantry.org)).
  - If you have the means, “sponsor” an impacted individual or family for a month. Post a note on your neighborhood association social media page and make an offer to purchase groceries if someone knows an individual or family in need.
  - Buy a bag or even a can of food and donate it to a local food drive. Every little bit helps!
