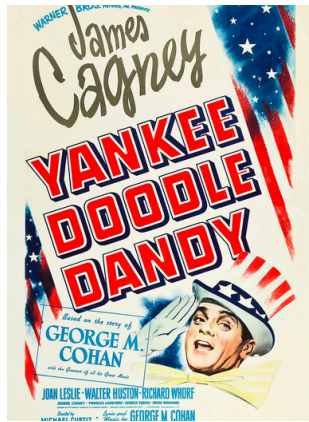


## FILMS

Enjoy these summer classics with Kristine over some popcorn!



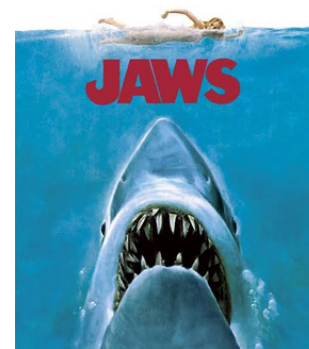
**July 10: Gidget (1959, 1 h 35 m)**
